The amount covers approximately 140 librarians and classified staff throughout the six libraries on the Pullman campus. Branch campus libraries have their own budgets.

Since Baker joined the WSU library team in 1991, 20 percent of her staff of librarians and classified personnel has been laid off. The cuts have not included temporary student positions.

At the same time, the university's Pullman libraries have not decreased in work load or services.

"We are sort of at a coping strategy," Baker said, "and if we have to go beyond that it will be virtually impossible to offer the same kinds of hours and services we offer now."

Losing staff members impacts the entire university, from students to faculty to librarian staff morale, said Cynthia Kaag, head of Brain Education Library.

Library staff cuts result in material not getting returned to shelves as quickly, the unavailability of employees to answer questions people might have and possibly decreasing hours of availability.

Kaag also said this time of the biennium makes library staff members edgy.

"There is a sense of uncertainty," she said.

to a process of bumping, said Vicki Croft, head librarian for the Veterinary . Medical/Pharmacy Library.

One result is staff members with the lowest seniority are laid off, and other staff members with more time at the university are shuffled to new positions.

Another result is staff members at higher levels are bumped to a lower-level position, Croft said.

Until the kinks of adjusting to new positions by bumped staff members are worked out, Croft said, a library's quality of service is impacted.

Part of Walter Dryfoos' job is to get private donations to help, in part, with continuing budget problems to support librarians and other people working in the libraries.

Dryfoos serves as the director of library development, a parttime position he has held for two years

Dryfoos said he asks donors to focus on excellence in the libraries.

Dryfoos also asks donors to focus on collection, development and preservation, library information systems technology, and unrestricted support for the library director to use at her discretion.

The principle behind this event is that people have equal rights regardless of gender, status or sexuality based on the Constitution.

The organizations believe people are not fully aware or are ignorant of this issue and need to realize that it is a reality.

"We are not trying to push homosexuality onto people, but to recognize their civil rights," Kreidler siad.

In addition to raising awareness, NOW has set up tables in the CUB throughout the week where students are asked to sign Valentine's Daycards in support of same-sex marriages.

So far, they have been receiving positive feedback and were able to get about 70 cards filled out which will be sent to the Legislature, said Kreidler.

Gov. Gary Locke is in favor of vetoing this bill and the organizations are asking people to support them by also contacting the Legislature themselves.
