"We want it to be seen as a highlight of the city of Pullman," Caires said.

Caires has made one round through the greek system asking for money and will go again in the fall. He said he is asking for \$100 donations.

Greek organizations are not the only ones targeted for contributions to the project.

During Mom's Weekend, Caires said he passed out literature and self-addressed stamped envelopes on Glenn Terrell Mall.

Caires met with WSU and city

officials Thursday night to discuss the project and more options for fund-raising including WSU alumni and national greek chapters.

An architect has been hired and is designing and laying out the project. Some of the early plans were discussed the meeting Thursday night.

Caires and Hunter Browne, an ASWSU Senator, brought the Campus Lighting Project proposal to city council members in December.

"There is horrible lighting on College Hill," Caires said. "We knew they wouldn't do anything unless we put our money where our mouth is."

He said the proposal can be directly attributed to ASWSU Jesse Harris

and the campaigning he did for improving campus safety.

The council placed \$50,000 into a sidewalk improvement fund in 1995 and adopted a goal to improve city sidewalks in 1996.

"I think it is a great idea," Honican said. "I know College Hill residents are really happy Matt took the initiative with this project."

Organizers anticipate the project will be a complete success and gain national attention.

"College students nationwide have never been instrumental in a project like this," Caires said.

The project is supposed to begin in the summer of 1997.

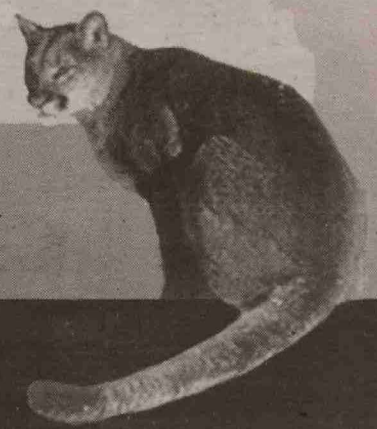
