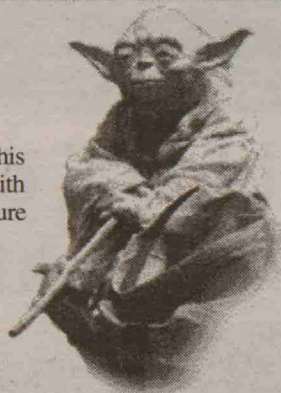

### X-wing (PC CD ROM)

A simulation game that makes you a rebel pilot, flying missions in an effort to prevent the Empire from attaining its evil goal. You can pilot any of the fighters that the rebellion utilizes, including the A, B, and Y-wings along with the all-purpose X-wing. The missions are roughly correspondent to the events of the films, beginning a little before Star Wars. An all-around excellent game, the strength of design and attention to detail are outstanding. You really feel satisfied after wiping out an armada of Tie interceptors and bombers. But if your ship gets destroyed in Empire territory and you get captured — Darth Vader and a torture droid await you. Know the satisfaction of receiving the Kalidor crescent for bravery, and get X-wing.

Shadows of the Empire (Nintendo 64)

This game itself makes purchase of the Nintendo 64 essential for Star Wars fans. Players assume the role of Dash Rendar, a Han Solo-type character who becomes mixed up in the rebellion. The first stage may be the best, as you pilot a snow-speeder against the Imperial invasion of Hoth. The sound, graphics, and storyline are all perfect. The gameplay in space rivals X-wing, when you are on the ground it resembles Tomb Raider, only better.
