News of the Day

Marine camp attacked

SAIGON (AP) — Some 1,200 North Vietnamese hammered at a U.S. Marine camp for three hours Monday before pulling back and leaving 179 Communist dead strewn over a battlescarred hillside. Charging beneath a mortar barrage and behind spewing flamethrowers, the men of the North Vietnamese 324B Division smashed into a perimeter defended by U.S. Marines, small detachments of U.S. Navy Seabees, Army Special Forces men and South Vietnamese militia-men.

178 Laborites ousted

LONDON (AP) — Voters continued to show disfavor with Prime Minister Harold Wilson's Labor party in 159 local elections Sunday, ousting at least 178 Laborites from district council seats.

Conservatives claimed they gained 186 seats and said Labor lost 179. The Labor party conceded only 178 losses. The Liberals claimed 28 gains.

The elections had no effect on Labor's 90-seat margin in the House of Commons and Wilson doesn't have to call a national election before spring 1971.

Relaxed laws called for

WASHINGTON (AP) — America's changing attitudes toward illicit sex, gambling, drinking and abortion require less strict criminal laws in these areas, says the President's crime commission.

Numerous so-called sin laws tie up police who could otherwise concentrate on matters threatening public safety, the commission said. Some of the laws aren't enforced anyway, it added in a report made public Sunday night.

Although string laws should be enforced in cases of rape, child molestation and organized vice, "the situation is less clear" regarding acts between consenting adults, including fornication, adultery, sodomy and homosexuality, the commission said.
