Doctor dies of gunshot wound

WENATCHEE — A local doctor has died from a gunshot wound to the chest, reportedly suffered while she was cleaning a gun at her home. Dr. Rosemary Casey, 40, died at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle shortly before 8 a.m. Monday. She was found uncon-

scious about 6 p.m. Sunday on the floor of her home's garage. Her husband, John Casey, told investigators she was accidentally shot while cleaning a hunting rifle, police said. Mrs. Casey was an obstetrician at Central Washington Hospital, where she was initially taken. She later was flown to Harborview.

Melynda Huskey, director of the GLBA, said the group is distributing

rainbow stickers from its office to show support for Shepard. She said it's also planning to hold a vigil in his honor sometime this week.

Henderson and McKinney originally were charged with attempted murder, kidnapping and aggravated robbery, but police said that with Shepard's death, the charges against them will be upgraded to first-degree murder, which carry possible death sentences.

death again later Monday at a political fund-raiser in New York. "The indications are he was beaten so badly because he was gay, by people who were either full of hatred or full of fear, or both," Clinton said. "We're supposed to create a place for every law-abiding citizen in this country, no matter how different we all are from one another."

While saying he should not comment on the specifics of the case, Clinton said "crimes of hate and crimes of violence cannot be tolerated in our country. In our shock and grief, one thing must remain clear: Hate and prejudice are not American values."

"The public outrage in Laramie and all across America today echoes what we heard at the White House Conference on Hate Crimes last year," Clinton said, pausing to talk with reporters on the South Lawn before boarding a helicopter for a fund-raising trip. "There is something we can do about this. Congress needs to pass our tough hate crimes legislation. It can do so even before it adjourns, and it should do so."

"I hope that in the grief of this moment for Matthew Shepard's family and in the shared outrage across America, Americans will once again search their hearts and do what they can to reduce their own fear and anxiety and anger at people who are different. And I hope that Congress will pass the hate crime legislation."

tency hearing 2 1/2 years ago," Appellate Judge David Thompson wrote in a 24-page opinion.

Appellate Judge Andrew Kleinfeld dissented, saying Sagastegui appeared very competent.

"He forfeited his right to do what he wants when he murdered three people," Kleinfeld said. "But the state is entitled to execute him for those murders, and he is entitled to control his defense or the lack of it unless he is incompetent to do so."

Vargas and other relatives had presented affidavits contending Sagastegui was subjected to chronic physical and sexual abuse by family members and neighbors as a child.

After the crimes, Sagastegui was given a mental exam and was found competent to stand trial and to act as his

own lawyer. At his trial in February 1996, he picked jurors based upon their willingness to sentence him to death.

Sagastegui was last examined by an independent forensic psychiatrist on Oct. 3 and found to be competent.

The state Supreme Court also upheld Sagastegui's execution.

Since the U.S. Supreme Court lifted its ban on the death penalty in 1976, the state of Washington has had two executions — Westley Allen Dodd in 1993 and Charles Rodman Campbell in 1994, both by hanging.
