Bill will open state-financed aid to historically Black colleges

OLYMPIA (U-WIRE) — Attending historically black colleges may become a little easier for Washington state residents in the near future.

House Bill 1574, a new piece of legislation sponsored by Rep. Dawn Mason (D-37), would allow Washington state students to use their home state financial aid funding to attend five historically Black colleges.

Students could attend Morehouse College, Clark-Atlanta University,

Spelman College, Morris-Brown College or Tuskegee University for any amount of time in pursuit of an undergraduate or graduate degree.

Any student's existing financial aid could be applied to a semester, a year of study or a full degree.

The bill, which would initiate a pilot program that would be evaluated in the year 2000, will receive a public hearing Friday in the House Higher Education Committee.

Mason said the program would provide solid educational opportunities for university students.

"The historically black colleges are unique in their ability to educate black leaders," she said.

Mason, who attended Tennessee
