Pullman Animal Control does accept unwanted pets as well, but its capacity is limited to 10 dogs and 14 cats.

Assistant Animal Control Officer Dianne Holmes said the Pullman agency has not had an overflow problem recently, though the numbers fluctuate.

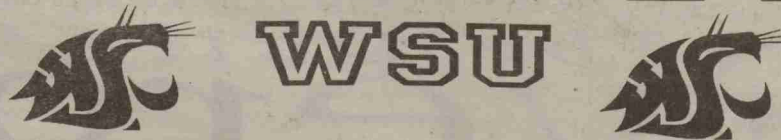
For those wishing to ease the problem by adopting a pet, Clark and his crew are located at 2019 White Ave. in Moscow. Their telephone number is 883-1166. Animals younger than 6 months old are \$26; those older are \$37, which includes spaying or neutering.

In Pullman the adoption fee is \$5 but a \$20 neutralization deposit must be paid if the dog is not spayed or neutered. Dogs older than 6 months require a \$1 temporary license as well.

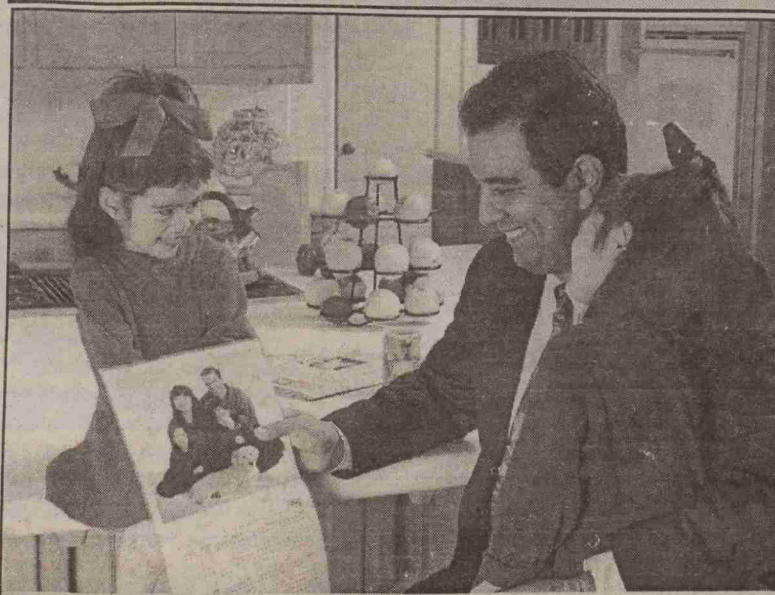
