

## Local espresso chain moves new image into Adam's Mall

Daily Grind Espresso plans to sell bagels, soups and salads

One less submarine sandwich shop and one more espresso stop may change the feel of Adam's Mall after Wednesday, with the opening of the Daily Grind Espresso as a "hang-out," said the owner.


