



have budgetary responsibilities, develop a process for an ongoing internal evaluation of the Center and Program, and act as a spokesperson for the GLBA program to the university community.

For Dupis and Jones to be filtered out from the other 53 candidates required a process of screening, reference checks, and telephone interviews. It was narrowed down to these two candidates who "came to the top all by themselves," said Gallagher.

Qualifications for the position included a master's degree, but a doctorate was preferred, in social sciences, education or a related field. A display of strong administrative and leadership qualities, as well as excellent com-

munication and interpersonal skills were necessary as well.

Both candidates had experience working in a higher education environment and have advocated for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgendered, and Ally issues, Gallagher said.

The new director will replace bobbi bonace (sic), who left WSU in August for a position in Monterey, Cal., at California State University.

Sitting in for bonace during the interim is Tori Byington, a microbiologist in the WSU College of Veterinary Medicine's Washington Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory.

She was asked to fill in because of her institutional experience and her position on the GLBA advisory board.
